Abstract	Indented both sides; justified (last line aligned left) c.150 words
Article type (if needed)	RESEARCH ARTICLE bold caps; aligned left
Body of text	1.5 spaced with 10 pt after; Times New Roman 12pt or Arial 11pt; aligned left; black
Dates	1 February 2001 (Not 1 <sup>st</sup> February 2001) 01/02/01 (date, month, year) – for use in tables only Twenty-first century
Document (file) type	All written submissions must be in .doc or .docx formats
Headings	SJoP only uses three levels of heading: H1: <b>Bold</b> H2: <b>Bold italic</b> H3: <i>Italic</i> Only first word and proper nouns capitalised; standard text-size
Hyperlinks	Underlined; black
Images	JPEG format (at least 300 dpi) via email  File name: title of paper_image1.jpg  Clear notation should be provided within the body of the text to indicate the placement of the image (e.g. INSERT IMAGE 1 HERE)
Journal abbreviation	"The Scottish Journal of Performance" may be abbreviated to "SJoP"
Language	All submissions must be in English (UK). Please avoid American spellings, except when used in a title or a citation.  Ordered:  1. First entry  1. Sub-point one 2. Sub-point two 2. Second entry  Unordered:  • Use bullets
Musical examples (audio)	Compressed MP3 file by email / online file storage provider File name: title of paper_audio1.mp3
Musical examples (written)	Typeset exported as image (JPEG – see <i>Images</i> ); minimum staff-height 6.5mm; notation at concert pitch preferred (if this is not practical, transpositions must be detailed); all non-standard notation explained

Names	On first mention, write the name in full; thereafter, surname only.
Numbers	Integers below 10 should be written-out (e.g. one, two, three). 10%, 10mm, 10kg (except at beginning of sentence, or chapters).
Order of sections	<ul> <li>Title</li> <li>Abstract</li> <li>Body of text</li> <li>Funding (if applicable)</li> <li>Acknowledgements (if applicable)</li> <li>References</li> <li>Appendices (if applicable)</li> <li>About the author</li> </ul>
Page Numbers	Lower case Roman numerals (i, vi, xxi, etc.); bottom, aligned right
Page Size	A4
Paragraphs Quotations	Fewer than 40 words: in-line text; single quotation marks; double quotation marks to be used for quotations within a quotation  More than 40 words: indented both sides; justified (last line aligned left); without quotation marks; author and year of publication aligned right below quotation

Title	Bold, only first word and proper nouns capitalised Centred; larger text-size
Video	Link to externally hosted version for peer review purposes (e.g. YouTube or Vimeo).
